- 4- Reasons for Choosing the Site
- **5-** The District of Mogineual has 108,333 inhabitants, 55,688 of whom are women. It also has 58 educational establishments from 1st to 12th grade, with 786 civil servants, in addition to traders and economic agents, and there is no school capable of occupying children from 2 to 5 years of age.

In this context, children are left without a job complicating the integration process when the formal school enrollment phase arrives. For this reason, APAI, in coordination with the local government, decided to

build a school for this purpose.
6- 4. Justification of the Project
Give occupation to children from 2 to 5 years old;
Psychologically prepare children to enter formal school;
Assist the Government, parents and guardians and the general population in the education of young children;
Contribute to the human development of the District of Mogincual.
7- 5. Project Objectives
Technically prepare the child's education in the process of teaching and learning (PEA) of childhood;
Diversify between traditional and formal education;
Ensure a good diet;
Create an atmosphere of fraternization among children;
Promote exchange of experience among children, awakening their emotional intellect;

8- Duration of the Project

The project will last for 12 months (1 year). Bearing in mind that a building will be built Porch within three (3) months.

After the end of funding, the Project will continue through its own funds (payment of registration fees, monthly fees, sale of uniforms for children and other services such as copying, typing and printing documents, services that the district does not have).

The District Government has already identified a space and has trained personnel for Childhood Education, at this moment, there is a lack of financial resources for the materialization of the project.
